2) International Student Mobility for International Students:

Students who are enrolled in international programs in these public universities are required to spend (1-4 semester) in host partner universities.

(a) double degree, where the students get their degree from both home and host universities,

(b) single degree (self founded mostly)

programs are managed by governments (Dewanto and Pritasari, 2023):

➤ **Erasmus +**

a fully funded scholarship program managed by the European Commission

➤ the **EACEA** (European Education and Culture Executive Agency) Agencies in program countries, and a series of national offices in some partner countries.

➤ **IISMA** (Indonesia International Student Mobility Award)

To prepare qualified Indonesian students with experience, knowledge, and skills to excel in future careers, as they believe that learning experience abroad will develop the most valuable skills for the future workplace.

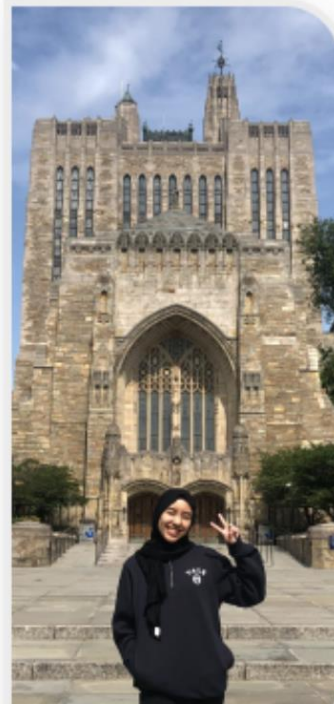

According to Jibeen and Khan (2015) through internationalization program is gave acces to university to meet demands that they cannot find in the local university and boost learning environemnt.
