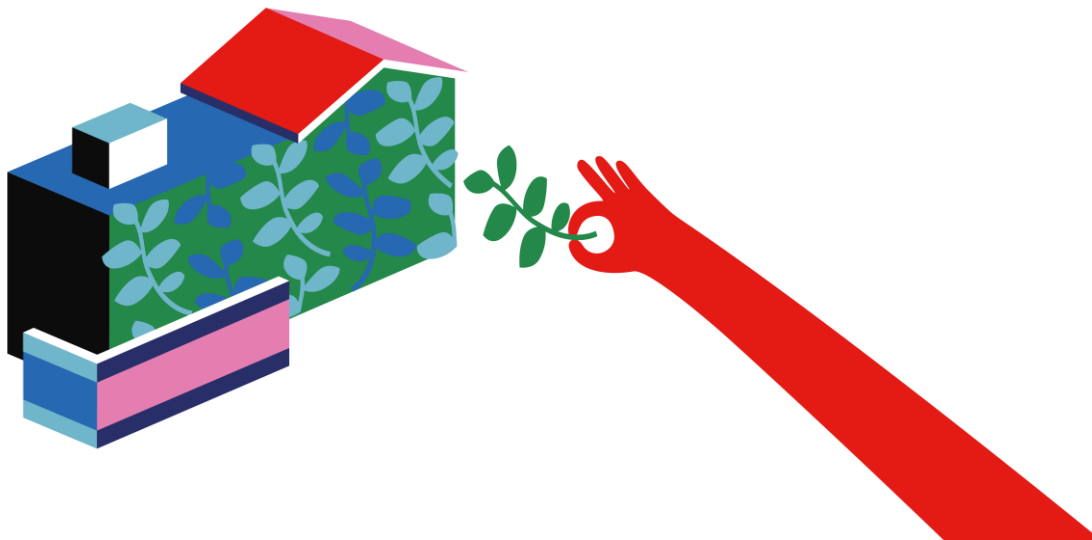

What is the Participatory Budget?

- It is a process that allows the population to decide on the allocation of a portion of the city's financial resources by voting on a list of projects designed by the residents themselves.

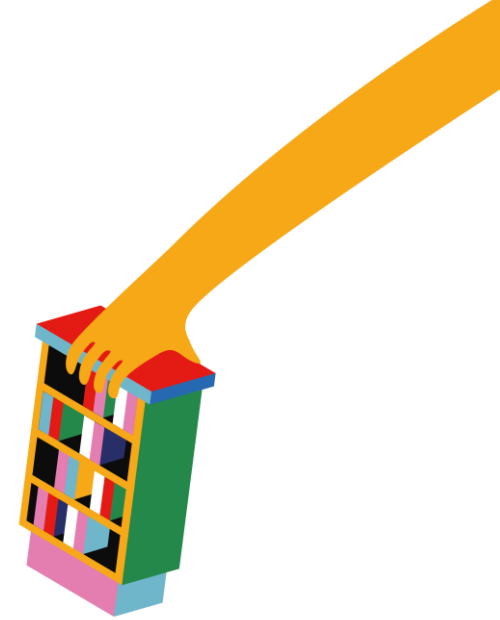


Origins of Participatory Budget

- Concept originated from Porto Alegre (1989)
- Nearly 3,000 participatory budgets worldwide



Phases of the Participatory Budget



- 1. Call for projects (approximately 6 months)**
- 2. Feasibility study (approximately 3 months)**
- 3. Votation (approximately 2 months)**
- 4. Implementation of projects (over 3 years)**

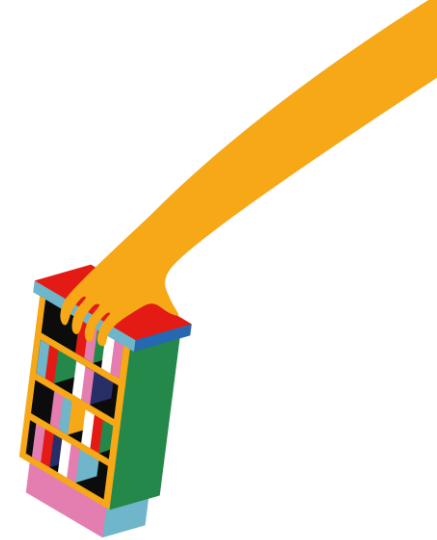

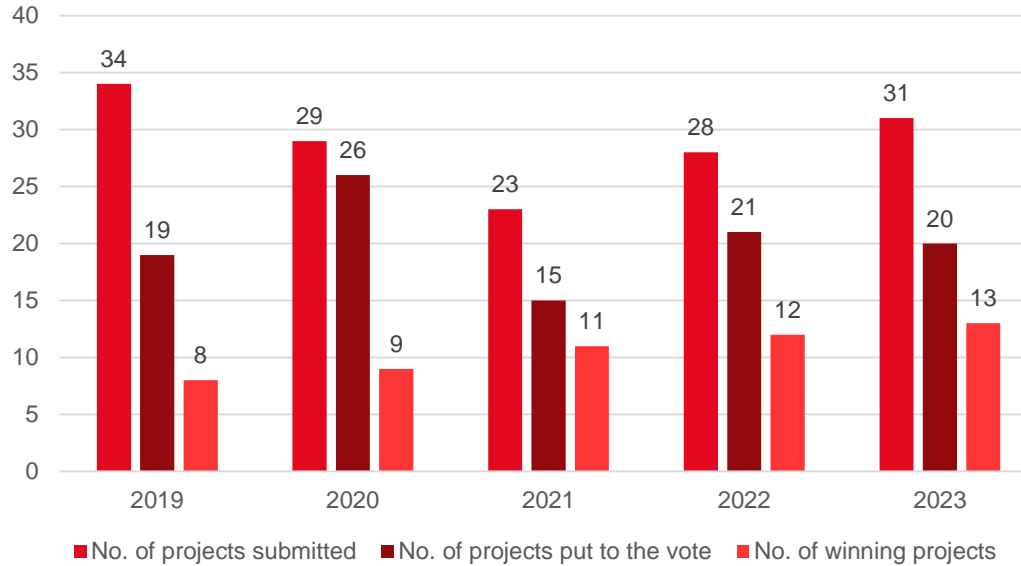




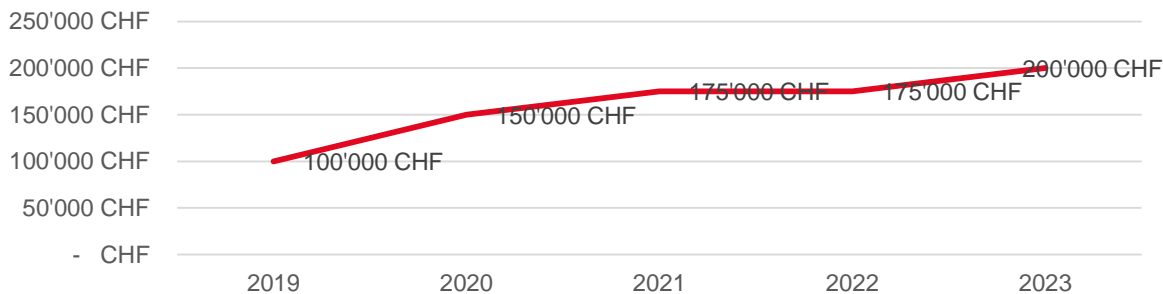

2. Feasibility study

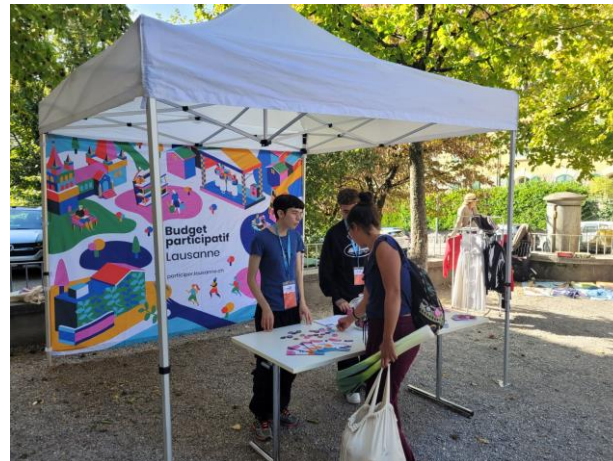
The entire Lausanne administration examines projects to ensure their technical and legal conformity.





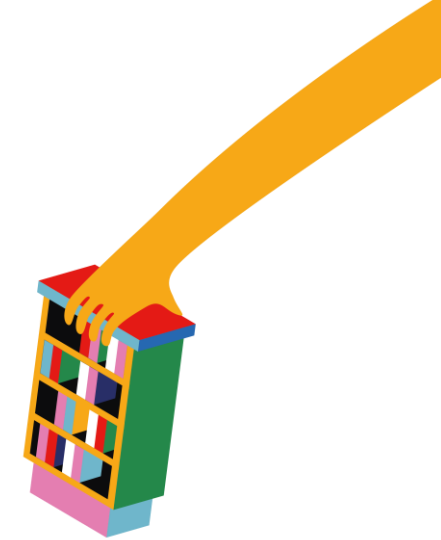
3. Votation

Each resident of Lausanne receives a personal ballot paper.

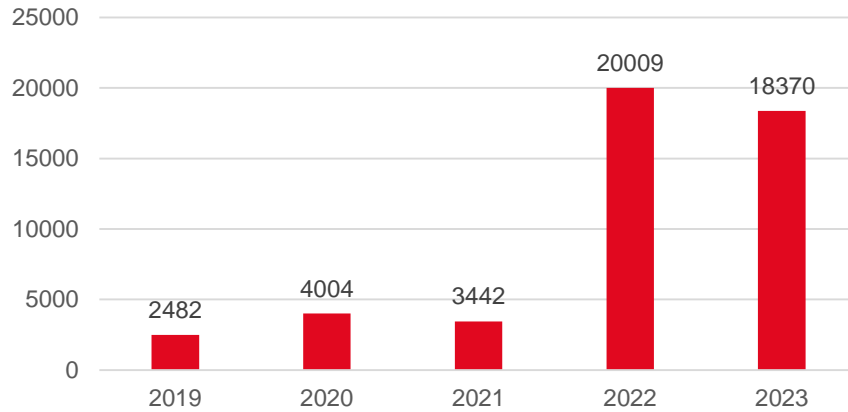




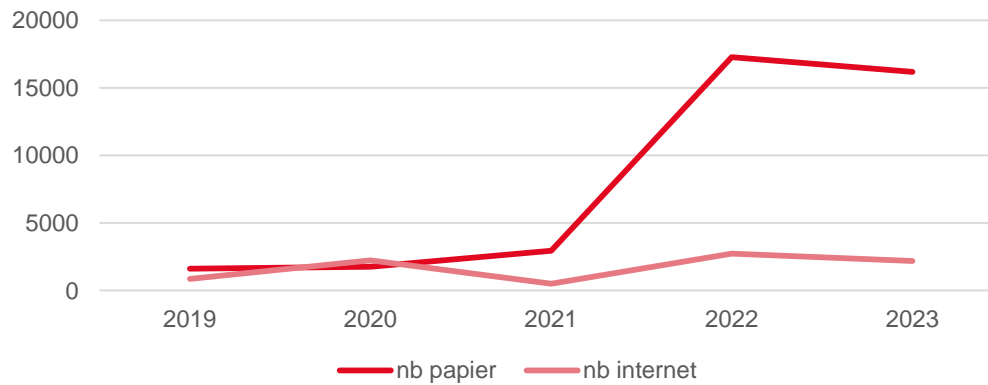
